Understanding the World (UW)

Investigate different types of potatoes - new, jacket, mashed, chips, crisps how are they the same, how do they differ?

Investigate different types of peas chick peas, frozen peas, mushy peas etc discuss similarities and differences, colour, size, smell

Where do worms live? Create a wormery to observe the worms

South-west Kenya. Can you find this on a map? Can you find out more about the country? How is it similar / different to where you live?

Make maps of Handa's journey along the road to Akeyo's house

Expressive Arts & Design (EAD)

Plan and think of what you need to design your own superhero character that is based on a different type of fruit or vegetable? Make your superhero

Arcimboldi was a famous artist who would often use fruit and vegetables to make pictures. Make a simple picture using them. It could be of a face or anything else you wanted.

Listen to a range of African music. Learn about different types of instruments used in Africa. Make a percussion instrument and use it to accompany African music. Learn about things to make a sound e.g. rice, pasta etc.
