

Remember PIGSS to edit your writing.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Write your own version of a ‘Shadowmancer’ story start. See at the bottom of the page for details. 2. Watch the Alma video on Literacy Shed. Rewrite the story of what happens. It’s Ghostly, so think of the words that would fit. Remember to punctuate carefully. https://www.literacyshed.com/alma.html <p>Before watching: There is quite a lot of suspense etc. Predict what happens at certain points e.g. What will happen when she goes into the shop? <p>English Writing</p> 	<p>Re-read this.</p> <p>Have a go at writing your own version of a 'Shadowmancer' story start.</p> <p>Where could you set yours? What creatures might you include? What 2 characters might you have that goes with this? Take your time with this.</p> <p>Remember to include: fronted adverbials (time, place, frequency, manner and possibility); speech using inverted commas, however don't use speech to tell the story (two pieces per paragraph is enough); expanded noun phrases, to add lots of description.</p>	<p>Shadowmancer text</p>
