Forest School: I have been asked to update parents about Forest School kit but will try to send reminders as necessary.

Forest School clothing is very much weather dependent. So if the forecast is cold, they will need additional warm clothing or if it is hot and sunny, they will need a hat/sun block.

Children need to have **separate shoes and coat** to their ordinary school clothing (something old that is ok to get muddy etc).

Children will also need to have **long sleeved tops and long trousers**. This is to keep them safe from midges and nettles.

We intend rolling this out over the whole year next year to other year groups and will send a letter notifying parents of the groups in advance of the Forest School sessions commencing.
