Absence: Good attendance and punctuality is important however, if your child needs to be absent from school, please call by **8.45am** and leave a message on our answerphone.

PE Kit: We have seen children getting the most out of not having to change for PE and gaining more PE lesson time so we are continuing with the request for children in Years 1-6 coming to school on their PE days in their PE kit (plain white T-shirt and blue or black shorts or joggers with a school jumper to keep warm as the winter weather sets in). EYFS children will need to bring their kit in for them to change into each week.

Pick up & drop off:

Pick up and drop off will return to normal from the start of this term. Children are welcome onto the playground from 8.30am and the whistle will be blown to line up at 8.45am. We request that parents leave as quickly as possible in the mornings so we can lock the gates.

The top pedestrian gates will be opened at 3.10pm for parents to collect Y1&2 children from their classroom doors.

Children in Reception and Years 3-6 can be collected from the bottom playground. We request parents wait in the area of the playground by the hall rather than by the classrooms.

We will have a slightly staggered finish to allow you to collect children from the relevant areas.

Mr Jenkinson will be on hand to help guide with any queries during the first few days if you are unsure.

Years 1 & 2 - Collect at 3.15pm.

Years 3-6 - Collected at 3.20pm (or older children in Y5&6 can walk home independently).
