Autumn	The season between summer and winter when the weather becomes cooler and the leaves fall off the trees.
Spring	The season between winter and summer when the weather becomes warmer and plants start to grow again.
Summer	The season between spring and autumn when the weather is usually warm or hot.
Winter	The season between autumn and spring when the weather is usually cold.
drizzling	Drizzle is light rain falling in fine drops.
harvest	The harvest is the collection of a crop.
crop	Plants such as wheat and potatoes that are grown in large quantities for food.
breezy	When the weather is breezy, there is a fairly strong but nice wind blowing.
temperature	The measure of how hot or cold it is.
fog	A thick cloud and make it difficult to see things.
cooler	A temperature which is low but not very low.
deciduous	A deciduous tree or bush is one that loses its leaves in the autumn every year.

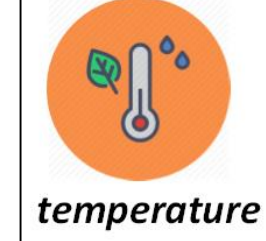
