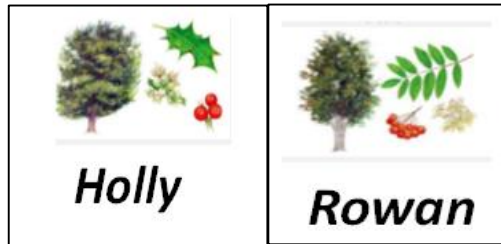


**Vocabulary**

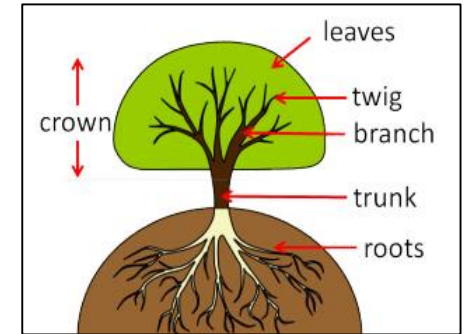
<b>plant</b>	A plant is a living thing that grows in the earth and has a stem, leaves, and roots.
<b>wild plants</b>	Wild plants live or grow on their own and are not looked after by people.
<b>garden plants</b>	Garden plants are planted by people and looked after by people.
<b>deciduous</b>	A deciduous tree or bush is one that loses its leaves in the autumn every year.
<b>evergreen</b>	An evergreen is a tree or bush which has green leaves all the year round.
<b>trunk</b>	An evergreen is a tree or bush which has green leaves all the year round.
<b>branch</b>	The branches of a tree are the parts that grow out from its trunk and have leaves, flowers, or fruit growing on them.
<b>root</b>	The roots of a plant are the parts of it that grow under the ground.
<b>stem</b>	The stem is the thin, upright part on which the flowers and leaves grow.
<b>flower</b>	A flower is the part of a plant which is often brightly coloured, grows at the end of a stem.
<b>petal</b>	The petals of a flower are the thin coloured or white parts which together form the flower.
<b>bulb</b>	A bulb is a root shaped like an onion that grows into a flower or plant.
<b>seed</b>	A seed is the small, hard part of a plant from which a new plant grows.

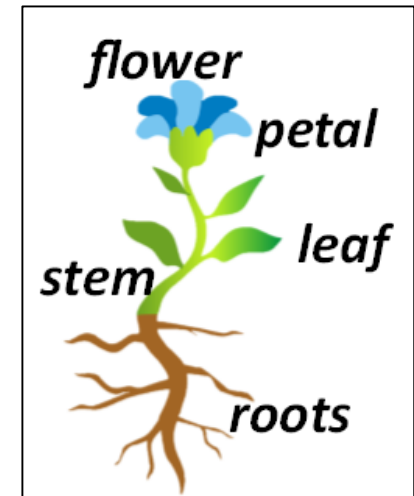

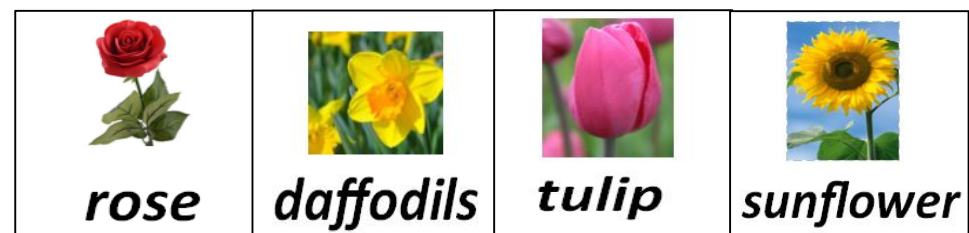
