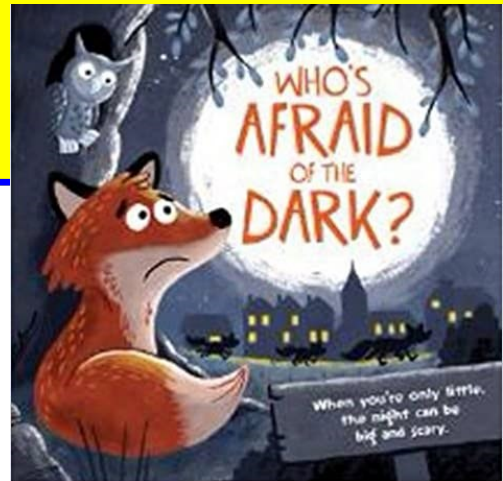
Y4 residential - thanks to all those who helped make Y4's overnight stay at Beaumanor Hall so successful. The children had an amazing
