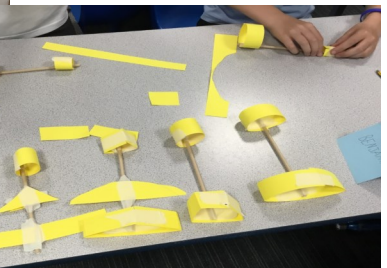
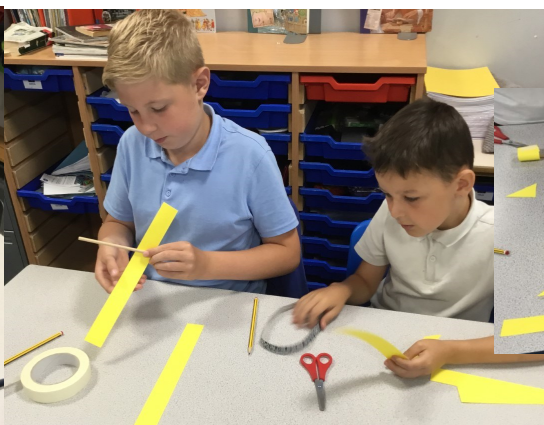

Year 6 enjoying their Forest Day

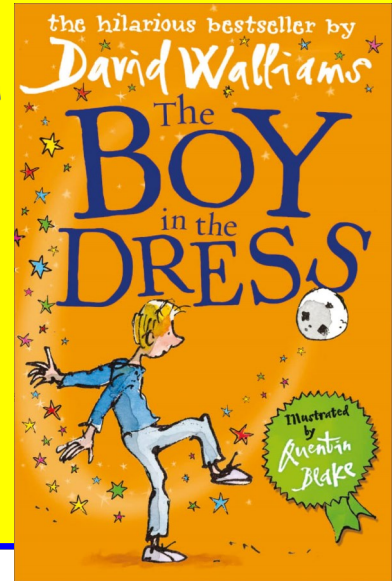


It has been a busy week at school this week especially with our Transition Day for students Y5 Glider designing and testing activity
